
Nonfarm Job Gains Above Post-Recession Average; Unemployment Rate Declines to 6.0%

Arizona's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate dropped one-tenth of a percentage point from 6.1% in October to 6.0% in November. The US seasonally adjusted unemployment rate remained unchanged at 5.0% in November. A year ago, the Arizona seasonally adjusted rate was 6.6% and the U.S. rate was 5.8% (see **Figure 1**).


Over the Month

Arizona gained 29,800 Nonfarm jobs (1.1%) in November (see **Figure 2**). This was more than the post-recessionary ('10-'14) average gain of 26,500 jobs. The Private Sector gained 27,100 jobs (1.2%), more than the post-recessionary ('10-'14) average gain of 24,900 jobs. Government gained 2,700 jobs, with gains recorded in Local Education (1,600 jobs) and State Education (400 jobs) offsetting losses within Federal Government (-200 jobs). Gains were recorded in nine of the eleven sectors, while two sectors posted losses. The largest gain was recorded in Trade, Transportation and Utilities (14,600 jobs), followed by Education and Health Services (3,400 jobs), Leisure and Hospitality (3,000 jobs), Government (2,700 jobs), Professional and Business Services (2,600 jobs), Construction (1,600 jobs), Manufacturing (1,000 jobs), Information (1,000 jobs) and Other Services (500 jobs). Financial Activities (-500 jobs) and Natural Resources and Mining (-100 jobs) recorded job losses.

Over the Year


Arizona Nonfarm employment grew by 2.5% (65,400 jobs) over the year in November (see **Figure 3**). The Private Sector accounted for a majority of the November gains, adding 63,200 jobs (2.9%). Government employment grew by 2,200 jobs in November. Ten of the eleven sectors reported job gains while one sector reported losses. The sectors with the largest gains included Education and Health Services (13,800 jobs) and Leisure and Hospitality (10,900 jobs). Other employment gains were reported in Trade, Transportation and Utilities (10,800 jobs), Professional and Business Services (9,800 jobs), Construction (6,900 jobs), Financial Activities (5,700 jobs), Other Services (4,000 jobs), Government (2,200 jobs), Information (1,700 jobs), and Manufacturing (600 jobs). Job losses were reported in Natural Resources and Mining (-1,000 jobs).

LABOR MARKET TRENDS CHARTS


**Arizona & U.S. Unemployment Rate
Seasonally Adjusted**




**Arizona & U.S. Nonfarm Employment

Year-to-Year Percent Change**




**Arizona & U.S. Manufacturing Employment
Year-to-Year Percent Change**




