Modest Nonfarm Job Gains in February; Unemployment Rate Declines to 5.5%

Arizona's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate dropped one-tenth of a percentage point from 5.6% in January to 5.5% in February. The U.S. seasonally adjusted unemployment rate remained unchanged at 4.9% in February. A year ago, the Arizona seasonally adjusted rate was 6.3% and the U.S. rate was 5.5% (see **Figure 1**).





Over the Month

Arizona gained 25,300 Nonfarm jobs (0.9%) in February (see **Figure 2**). This was more than the post-recessionary ('10-'15) average gain of 23,000 jobs. The Private Sector gained 10,500 jobs (0.5%), which is less than the post-recessionary ('10-'15) average gain of 12,000 jobs in February. Gains were recorded in six of the eleven sectors, while four sectors posted losses, and one sector remained unchanged. The gains were recorded in Government (14,800 jobs); Leisure and Hospitality (5,900 jobs); Education and Health Services (3,100 jobs); Construction (2,700 jobs); Financial Activities (2,100 jobs); and Other Services (1,100 jobs). The losses were recorded in Trade, Transportation and Utilities (-2,800 jobs); Manufacturing (-1,400 jobs); Information (-100 jobs); and Natural Resources and Mining (-100 jobs).

Professional and Business Services showed neither significant gains nor significant losses (0 jobs).






Over the Year




Arizona Nonfarm employment grew by 3.0% (79,200 jobs) over the year in February (see **Figure 3**). The Private Sector accounted for a majority of the February gains, adding 81,600 jobs (3.7%). Government employment declined by 2,400 jobs (-0.6%) in February. Nine of the eleven sectors reported job gains, while two sectors reported losses. The sectors with the largest gains included Education and Health Services (19,600 jobs); Professional and Business Services (16,800 jobs); and Trade, Transportation and Utilities (12,200 jobs). Additional employment gains were reported in Financial Activities (12,100 jobs); Leisure and Hospitality (8,400 jobs); Construction (8,100 jobs); Information (2,200 jobs); Manufacturing (2,100 jobs); and Other Services (1,300 jobs). Job losses were reported in Natural Resources and Mining (-1,200 jobs) and Government (-2,400 jobs).
