
**Nonfarm Job Losses Below Post-Recession Average Loss;
Arizona Unemployment Rate Increases to 5.9%**

Arizona's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate increased a tenth of a percentage point from 5.8% in May to 5.9% in June. The U.S. seasonally adjusted unemployment rate dropped two-tenths of a percentage point from 5.5% in May to 5.3% in June. A year ago, the Arizona seasonally adjusted rate was 6.8% and the U.S. rate was 6.1% (see **Figure 1**).




Over the Month

Arizona shed 46,800 Nonfarm jobs (-1.8%) in June (see **Figure 2**). This was less than the post-recessionary ('10-'14) average loss of 55,200 jobs. Both the Private Sector (-5,500 jobs) and Government (-41,300 jobs) lost jobs. The majority of losses in Government were from Local Education (-39,100 jobs). Three of the eleven sectors gained jobs, while five posted losses. The remaining two sectors were flat in June. The largest gain was in Professional & Business Services which added 3,300 jobs. Gains were also reported in Construction (900 jobs), Information (500 jobs), and Natural Resources and Mining (100 jobs). Sectors which reported losses include Government (-41,300 jobs), Leisure & Hospitality (-6,500 jobs), Educational and Health Services (-2,800 jobs), Other Services (-900 jobs), and Financial Activities (-100 jobs).


Over the Year

Arizona Nonfarm employment grew by 2.1% (53,500 jobs) over the year in June (see **Figure 3**). The Private Sector accounted for all of the gains adding 58,200 jobs. Government cut payroll by 4,700 jobs in June. Eight of the eleven major sectors reported job gains and three reported losses. The sectors with the largest gains included Professional and Business Services (15,800 jobs) and Education & Health Services (14,700 jobs). Other gains were reported in Leisure & Hospitality (9,800 jobs), Other Services (5,900 jobs), Trade, Transportation & Utilities (5,500 jobs), Financial Activities (4,800 jobs), and Construction (3,100 jobs). Over-the-year job losses were reported in Government (-4,700), Manufacturing (-1,000 jobs), and Natural Resources & Mining (-500 jobs).




Arizona & U.S. Unemployment Rate Seasonally Adjusted




Arizona & U.S. Nonfarm Employment Year-to-Year Percent Change



Arizona & U.S. Construction Employment Year-to-Year Percent Change





Arizona & U.S. Manufacturing Employment Year-to-Year Percent Change
