Arizona’s Private Sector Gained 24,500 jobs in October 2018
Nonfarm employment increased 3.1% over the year

Arizona’s unemployment rate increased to 4.7% in October 2018 from 4.6% in September 2018. During that same period, Arizona’s seasonally adjusted labor force level increased by 16,309 individuals. From October 2017 to October 2018, Arizona’s seasonally adjusted labor force level increased by 60,585 individuals. The U.S. seasonally adjusted unemployment rate remained at 3.7% in October 2018.

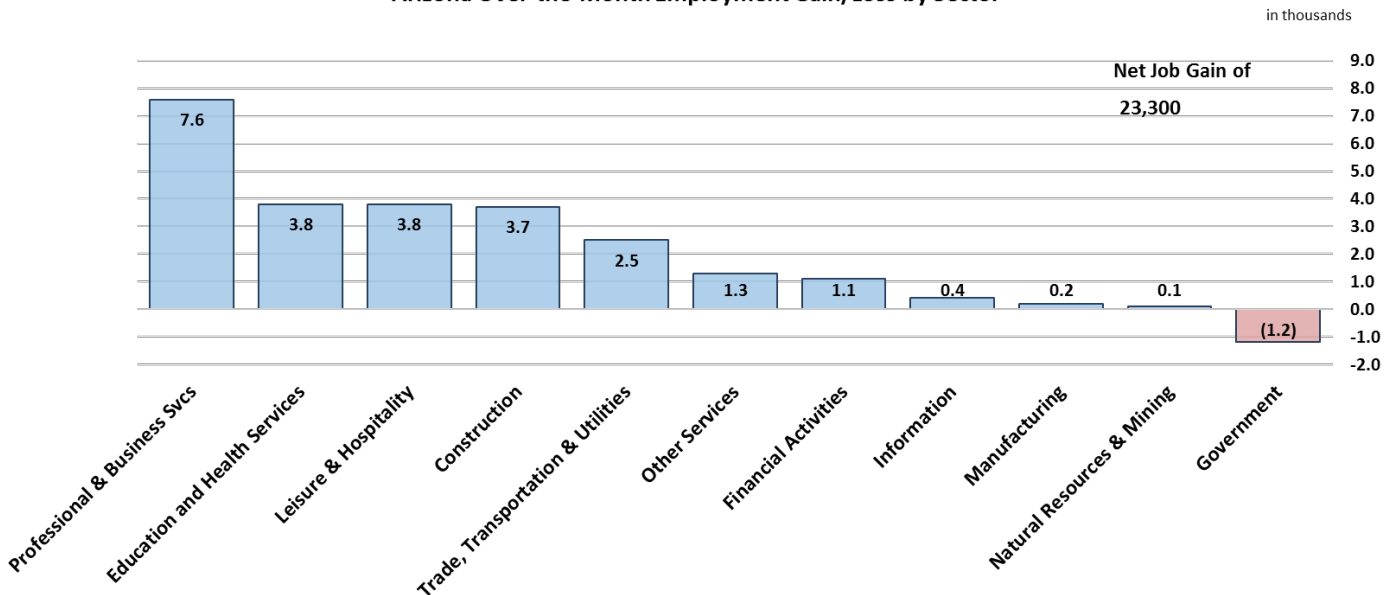

Overall, Arizona gained 23,300 nonfarm jobs in October 2018, which is lower than the historical post-recession (2010 – 2017) average gain of 25,600 jobs in October.

The government sector recorded a net loss of 1,200 jobs, which is differs from the historical post-recession (2010 – 2017) average gain of 3,300 jobs in October.

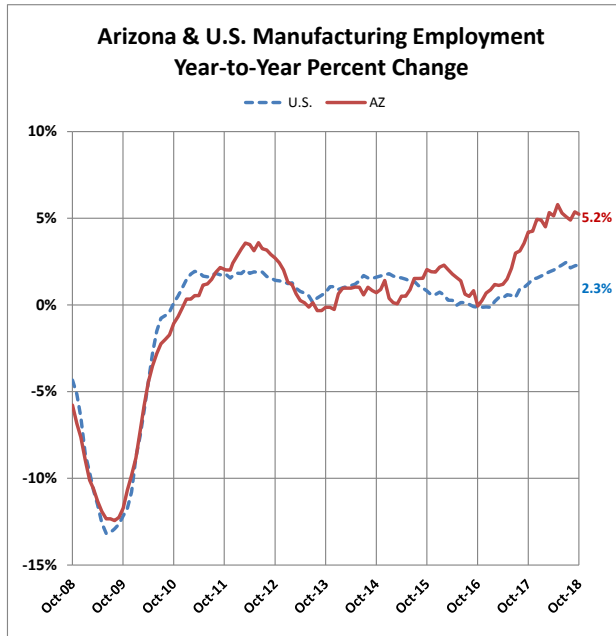
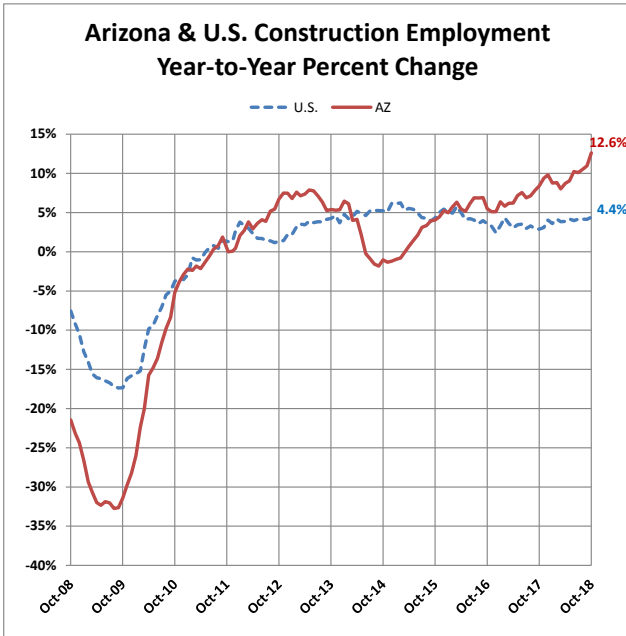
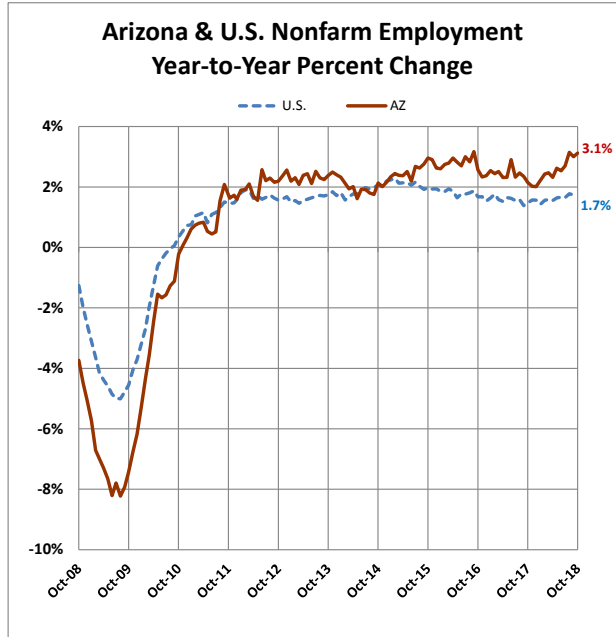
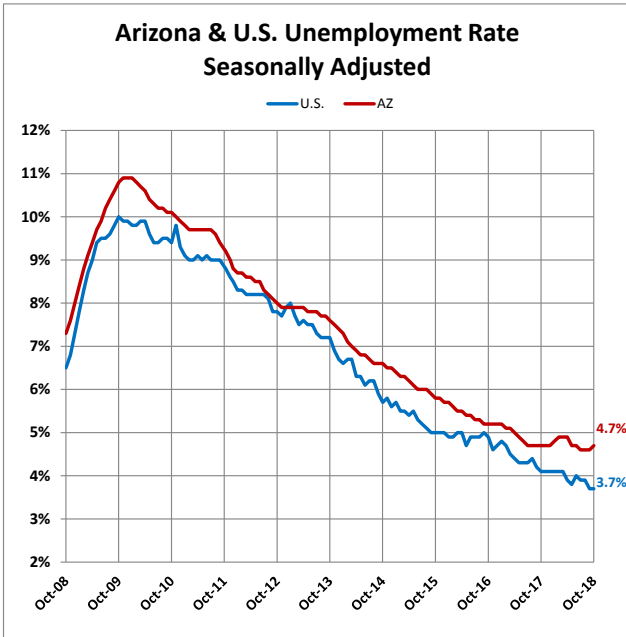
Over the Year

Employment in Arizona increased 3.1% year over year. From October 2017 to October 2018, Arizona recorded a net gain of 87,800 nonfarm jobs, with the majority (84,900) in the private sector. Government recorded gains of 2,900 jobs from October 2017 to October 2018. Gains were reported in:

- Construction (18,900 jobs)
- Professional & Business Services (14,400 jobs)
- Education & Health Services (13,300 jobs)
- Leisure & Hospitality (12,600 jobs)
- Manufacturing (8,700 jobs)
- Trade, Transportation, & Utilities (7,300 jobs)

- Natural Resources & Mining (200 jobs)

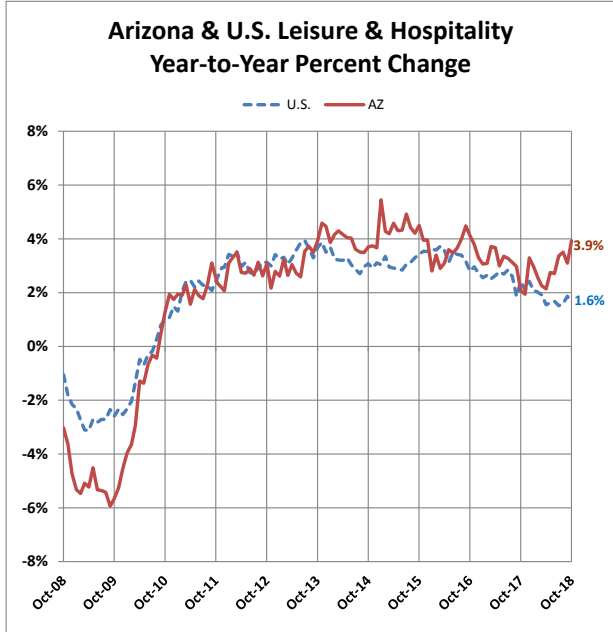
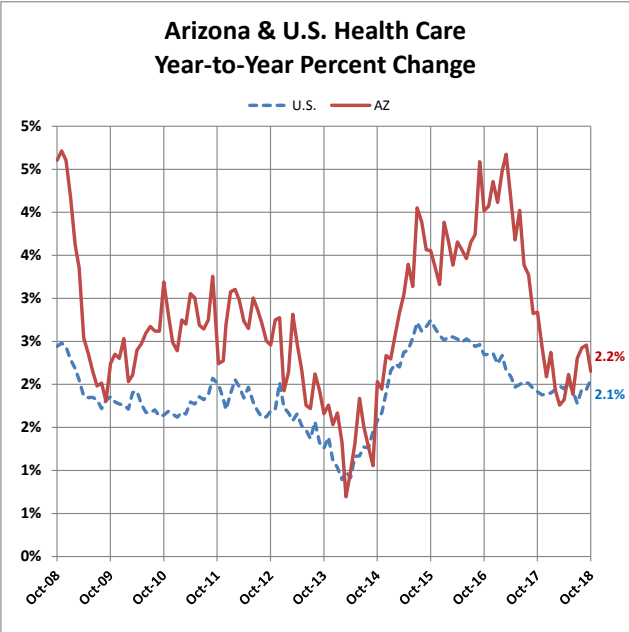
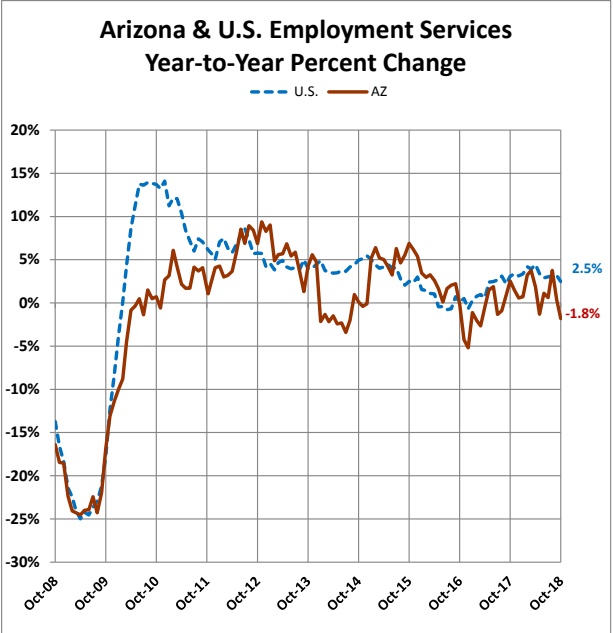


LABOR MARKET TRENDS CHARTS
